Regents Exam & Diploma Information

Updated April 2020

The cancellation of the June 2020 Regents exams means the following:

Students enrolled in courses ending in a Regents exam are exempt from passing the Regents exam upon earning course credit in June 2020.

Students who have previously earned course credit, but did not pass the Regents exam and planned to re-take the Regents exam in June 2020 are exempt from that Regents exam.

Exempt from the following Regents:

Any exam a student had previously attempted but had not yet earned a passing score (must have course credit)

Additional information on Diploma Designations:

Honors Designation - average of all Regents exams is over a 90 - will be determined using scores on Regents exams taken prior to and after June 2020. (Fewer than five [Regents] or eight [Adv. Regents] exams may be used to determine this designation.)

Mastery in Math and/or Mastery in Science Designation - three math exams and/or three science exams each over an 85 - will be determined using scores on Regents exams taken prior to <u>and</u> after June 2020. (*Two exams in each subject area may be used to determine this designation as opposed to using three exams in each subject area.*)
