The shekeres were created with water cooler jugs, string and beads. Students worked in groups to string the beads and attach them to the water bottles.

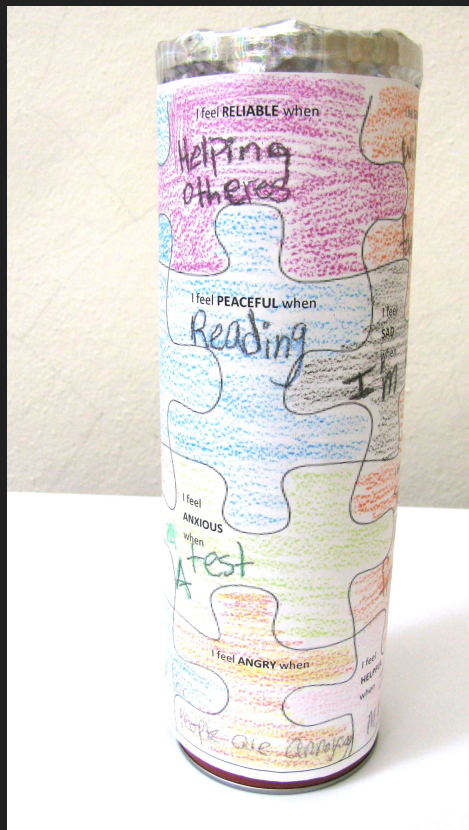
Creating these instruments helped students with teamwork, communication, motor skills, identifying emotions, choice making and musical performance
